Dear Transportation Provider:

For the first time this year, Miami-Dade County (MDC) will host WrestleMania on April 1, 2012. Executives from the World Wrestling Entertainment, Inc. have requested the issuance of temporary limousine permits to ensure the event is able to meet the transportation needs of the thousands of people who will visit our community during those days preceding and immediately after WrestleMania in a manner that will create a lasting positive impression.

In response to this request, Miami-Dade County has developed rules and regulations to facilitate temporary licensing while assuring the protection of the public through compliance with Code requirements. Temporary licenses will be issued to existing Miami-Dade license holders who desire to add vehicles to their fleet for this event. Temporary licenses will be valid only for the period of March 26, 2012 through April 6, 2012.

Attached please find the temporary for-hire limousine license application. Please read the application carefully and submit completed applications within the time period specified to: Sustainability, Planning and Economic Enhancement Department, 140 W. Flagler Street, #904, Miami, Florida, 33130. Walk-in applications will be accepted at our office starting on March 19, 2012 and if all requirements are met, you will be able to receive your decal(s) the same day.
