Description of Project/Bid: To establish a contract to furnish all supervision, labor, materials, tools, equipment & performing all operations required to replace the existing twin 36' culverts from Russian Colony Canal to Miami Canal (C-6) with a 75" x 112" arch pipe culver; construction of sand-cement headwalls; installation of a fish guard device; earthwork; implementation of erosion and sediment control; maintenance of traffic; fence and guardrail installation & improvements to the intersection including pavement reconstruction, milling, resurfacing, and pavement markings. Also; installation of Weather and Environmental Information Sensor Station (WEISS) consisting of tower, rain gauge, satellite telemetry unit, incidental items to install telemetry equipment and integrate the SCADA equipment into the County network; all wiring,

Reasons for Recommendation

An analysis of the factors contained in Section VI C of Implementing Order 3-22 indicate that a 3.69% Construction subcontractor goal is appropriate in the trades as follows: Highway, Street, and Bridge Construction (pavement marking & signage .51%); and All Other Specialty Trade Contractors (guardrail & fence 3.18%). Attempts were made to make this project a Set Aside; however, only two (2) firms responded as being able to meet the contract's requirements.
