CLERK'S SUMMARY AND OFFICIAL MINUTES
CHARTER REVIEW TASK FORCE – FINAL PUBLIC HEARING
JUNE 20, 2012

The Miami-Dade Charter Review Task Force (Task Force) convened on June 20, 2012, in the Commission Chambers on the Second Floor of the Stephen P. Clark Center, 111 N.W. 1st Street, Miami, Florida, at 5:00 p.m. There being present Chairman Rene Garcia, Vice Chairwoman Evelyn Langlieb Greer, Mayor Carlos Bermudez, Mr. Victor Diaz, Councilwoman Isis Garcia-Martinez, Councilman Luis Gonzalez, Mr. Carlos Manrique, Mr. Louis Martinez, Mr. Terry Murphy, Mr. Hans Ottinot, Mr. Lawrence Percival, Ms. Pamela Perry, Professor H.T. Smith; (Members Mr. Armando Bucelo, Representative John Patrick Julien, Reverend Dr. Walter Richardson, Mayor Donald Slesnick, and Representative Carlos Trujillo were absent).

In addition to the members of the Task Force, the following staff members were present: Assistant County Attorneys Oren Rosenthal, Jess McCarty, and Eugene Shy; Inson Kim, Les Pantin, and Lorna Mejia from the Mayor's Office; and Deputy Clerk Mary Smith-York.

The Charter Review Task Force reconvened for the purpose of conducting a public hearing to allow public feedback on its recommendations. Prior to opening the public hearing, Chairman Garcia reviewed the purpose of the CRTF and the public hearing protocol.

Chairman Garcia opened the public hearing and the following persons appeared before the Task Force:

Mr. Nelson Hernandez, Councilman, Town of Miami Lakes, 15900 W. Troon Circle, appeared before the Committee and expressed his support of Vice-Chairwoman Greer's proposal on incorporation. He stated that incorporated areas could bring a number of efficiencies to the County. He asked that the Task Force consider some type of arrangement that would facilitate the full incorporation of Miami-Dade County. If at the end of this process, some enclaves remain, the Commission should step in to increase the level of services provided to those areas.

Mr. Tom Hutton, 11025 SW 119 Street, Miami, appeared before the Committee and commented on minimizing the commissioners' involvement in the incorporation process and maintaining the 10 percent registered voter requirement.

Ms. Bonnie Hutton, 11025 SW 119 Street, Miami, appeared before the Committee and stressed the importance of citizens' self-determination and their right to petition. She also noted she supported the 10 percent registered voter requirement.

Mr. Denny Wood, 9855 E. Burn Street, Miami, appeared before the Committee and asked the Task Force to address corruption in Miami-Dade County by amending the Charter to

make it illegal for any individual running for County Commissioner to accept campaign contributions from County vendors including corporate officers, family members, and employees. He noted the City of Palmetto Bay and the City of South Miami enacted similar legislation.

Mr. Jeffrey Bercow appeared before the Committee and addressed issues relating to the Comprehensive Development Master Plan (CDMP). He noted the Code made it extremely difficult to move the Urban Development Boundary (UBD), and asked that the protections currently contained in the Code and the CDMP be maintained. He spoke in support of the Task Force's proposed Charter amendment requiring a two-thirds vote of the County Commission to move the UDB.

Chairman Garcia relinquished the Chair to Vice Chairwoman Greer.

Mr. Alan Rigerman, 17910 NW 84 Avenue, Palm Springs North, appeared before the Committee and spoke in support of the following proposed Charter amendments: 1) the proposed salary compensation for commissioners provided salaries be capped at \$100,000 per year and outside employment be prohibited; 2) that commissioners be prohibited from lobbying for a three to five year period after leaving office; that the Jackson Health System (JHS) become a public entity; and that incorporation proposals submitted by communities seeking to incorporate. Mr. Rigerman also suggested the Rules of Decorum to County Commission meetings be consistent with those in Miami Lakes, South Miami, and the Miami-Dade County School Board.

Mr. Alan Markelson, 8000 East Drive, North Bay Village, appeared before the Committee and spoke about the critical financial issues faced by JHS and the alleged incidents that lead up to the crisis.

Mr. Gary Stevenson, 6825 Rue Notre Dame, Miami Beach, activist with Our Jackson, Save Jackson campaign, appeared before the Committee and expressed support for JHS being maintained as a public institution. He suggested that the economic challenges faced by JHS be handled through the growth of primary care clinics.

Ms. Martha Baker, 1685 Cleveland Road, Miami Beach, appeared before the Committee and stressed the importance of exercising due diligence with regard to health care. She suggested that it was preferable to attempt to remedy the situation at Jackson Hospital through ordinances rather than through Charter amendments, and noted the County Commission had already addressed many of this Task Force's proposed recommendations. She noted she had some concerns regarding the proposal to create a self-appointed Board with an accompanying and self-appointed nominating council.

Mr. Andrew Nierenberg, 13725 SW 104 Court, Miami, co-chair for the Steering Committee for Incorporation of The Falls, appeared before the Committee and commented on the seven-year moratorium on incorporation. He urged Task Force members to keep the County Commission out of the incorporation process, and noted he supported the proposals presented by Vice-Chairwoman Greer and Mr. Slesnick. Mr.

Nierenberg said he was opposed to the proposal to prohibit commissioners from outside employment and proposals to strengthen the Conflict of Interest provisions and ethical standards.

Ms. Cecilia Stewart, 1899 NW 1 Court, Miami, appeared before the Committee and noted she supported the proposals to maintain Jackson Memorial Hospital as a public hospital.

Ms. Beverly Gerald, 14271 SW 74 Court, Miami, appeared before the Committee and spoke in support of the proposal to allow municipalities to incorporate. He stressed the importance of allowing the incorporation process to proceed without interference from the County Commission.

Mr. Thomas Lander, 3186 Roosevelt Street, Hollywood, teacher with Miami-Dade County Public Schools, appeared before the Committee and spoke against the privatization of Jackson Memorial Hospital.

Ms. Shanerman (phonetic) appeared before the Committee and spoke in support of allowing cities to incorporate.

Mr. Donny Dandy, 4851 NW 5 Avenue, Miami, appeared before the Committee and spoke in support of Jackson Memorial Hospital remaining a public hospital and stressed the need for a primary care clinic in the Liberty City area.

Dr.Carolyn Van Vliet, 13941 SW 92 Avenue, Miami, representing the Steering Committee for Incorporation of The Falls and LINC – Let’s Incorporate Now Coalition, appeared before the Committee and expressed support for placing many Task Force recommendations on the ballot. She spoke in support of the proposal to increase commissioners’ salaries.

Mr. Keon Hardemon, 1350 NW 8 Court, Miami, appeared before the Committee and spoke in support of maintaining Jackson Memorial Hospital as a public institution.

Mr. Hamilton, 7860 SW 86 Street, Miami, appeared before the Committee and spoke in support of a salary increase for County Commissioners from \$6000 to a reasonable amount approved by the voters. He also spoke in support of the proposed to removing the County Commission from the incorporation process.

Ms. Kathy Charles, 15471 SW 152 Street, Miami, appeared before the Committee and spoke in support of term limits, codifying the UDB requirements, incorporation of municipalities, and giving people a forum to address violations outside of the court system. She also spoke in support of increasing commissioners’ salaries consistent with the formula established in the State Statute and prohibiting commissioners’ from outside employment.

Mr. Max Samuel, 8951 NW 8 Avenue, Miami, appeared before the Committee and spoke in support of allowing municipalities to incorporate if approved by a majority of the electorate.

Ms. Renita Holmes, 5800 NW 7 Avenue, Miami, appeared before the Committee and spoke in support of preserving Jackson Memorial Hospital as a public hospital.

Ms. Paulette Darrow, 2422 NW 12 Avenue, Miami, appeared before the Committee and spoke in support of preserving Jackson Memorial Hospital as a public institution.

Ms. Marva Lightbourne, 5561 NW 7 Court, Miami, stressed the importance for the County Commission to educate the public on the incorporation process and for Jackson Memorial Hospital to remain a public hospital.

Mr. Norbert Lamenca, 10243 SW 126 Street, Miami, appeared before the Committee and spoke against incorporation and asked the Task Force members to consider changing the registered voter requirement to 25 percent. He stressed the need for more transparency in the incorporation process.

Ms. Mary Lee Hill, 146 NW 67 Street, Miami, appeared before the Committee and commented on various County issues.

Vice-Chairwoman Greer closed the public hearing after no other persons appeared wishing to speak.

Vice-Chairwoman Greer expressed appreciation to all those who appeared before the Task Force and noted any additional public input could be provided through e-mails or comments at the MiamiDade.gov Website.

Mr. Manrique encouraged members of the public to come to the County Commission meeting on July 17, 2012, to show their support for the Task Force's recommendations.

Vice-Chairwoman Greer advised that the next Task Force meeting was scheduled for June 26, 2012, at 9:00 a.m.

ADJOURNMENT:

There being no further business to come before the Charter Review Task Force, the meeting was adjourned at 8:17 p.m.

Financial Planning Background In the last few years many of us have observed many friends and family members lose jobs, businesses, homes and suffer significant salary reductions because of a sustained decrease in the County property taxes collected. Recently, while reading the Bible and came across the story of Joseph in the book of Genesis. Basically, after a series of bad events, Joseph was ultimately put in charge of Egypt. The reason Pharaoh placed Joseph in charge of Egypt was because of the wisdom he displayed when Pharaoh needed to have his dreams interpreted. Joseph told Pharaoh that his dreams were a message that seven years of abundant harvest would be followed seven years of famine. This is a great reminder that economic cycles have been going on for thousands of years and are actually normal. Economies go up and they go down. Weâ?Tve seen this here in the United States. In the past 70 years, the US has had 12 recessions averaging about 10 months each. Joseph knew Egypt was in the midst of an economic boom (part of the economic cycle). Joseph told Pharaoh that for the next seven years they should save one fifth (20%) of the harvest of Egypt during the seven years of abundance. This way, when the famine came they would have enough food to survive the coming famine. The plan worked to perfection. I canâ?Tt help but think about our own economy and how it parallels this story. We just came out of a time of great abundance and now weâ?Tre in a tougher time. Those that stored up provisionally during the boom time arenâ?Tt really affected by whatâ?Ts going on right now. They are barely affected by any economic slowdown. Those that didnâ?Tt have the foresight to store up for the coming famine are faring much worse. Recommendation That the Charter be amended to set a requirement for at least 20% of the surplus property tax dollars, when the property tax monies collected exceeds a 5-year running average of same, be collected and placed in an emergency fund to be used during economic downturns. In other words: Current fiscal year property taxes collected minus 5-year average of property tax monies collected multiplied by .20 (20%) would be saved, for every year the property tax monies exceeds the 5-year average. The 20% figure can be adjusted based on financial calculations regarding how much of a safety net we would need if a similar sustained decrease in collected property tax monies were to re-occur.
