Reduce Pollution Dispose of Toxic Batteries Properly

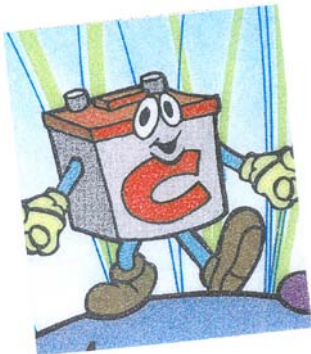
Some batteries can be tossed out with household trash
For example: non-rechargeable AAA, AA, C, D, 6V and 9V batteries

Other batteries can not – they are toxic
For example: all button, lithium, car batteries and most rechargeable ones

They contain hazardous heavy metals

Nickel Cadmium
Nickel Metal Hydride
Lithium Ion
Small Sealed Lead

Dispose of toxic batteries properly
