

Parks System Map




NW 114th Avenue Park

Located on 114th Avenue between 80th street and 82nd street

History of NW 114th Avenue Park

- NW 114th Avenue Park is conceived as a place in which the community can gather to enjoy sports, cultural arts, and nature in a safe environment that is representative of the beautiful City of Doral
- Land was purchased by the City of Doral.
- Final land purchase for park occurred in late 2010.



NW 114th Avenue Park:

- On February 19th Wannemacher Jensen Architects was selected as the top shortlisted firm for RFQ #2013-29 for the Engineering Services and Related Disciplines for NW 114th Ave Park.



History of Doral North Park

- Parkland acquired in two phases: 2007 (East) and 2009 (West)
 - Land was purchased by the City from Atlas I, II, and III. Now under ownership of Doral Commons.
 - City entered into a Settlement Agreement (June 2006)
- Florida Communities Trust – Florida Forever Program (2009)
 - Purchase west parcel (15 acres)
 - \$3,613,420 (40% reimbursement)
 - Certain amenities and activities must be built/completed on-site
 - **Completion of Management Plan requirements pending**



Doral North Park: Future



AGREEMENT

- Drainage Easement and Mining Agreement with Doral Commons (2012) Resolution No. 12-130
 - 12 acres lake and wetland
 - Doral Commons to provide fill material derived from lake for park. Cost will be split between City and Developer

GRANT

- Land and Water Conservation Fund Grant (FY 2013 – 2014)
 - \$200,000 (50-50 match)
 - Must be completed by 2017
 - Agreement stipulates certain amenities within park

Doral Trolley



- Launched on February 1, 2008, with one vehicle to provide an alternative transportation method which would also contribute to reduce traffic congestion and reduce green house gases.
- Since then, we have expanded to three routes with five vehicles.





Trolley Routes

Route 1 (Blue)

- Circulates around most of the City and provides connectivity to major destinations
- Serviced by 3 trolleys

Route 2 (Yellow)

- Provides service between the employment areas and the Palmetto Metrorail Station
- Serviced by 1 trolley

Route 3 (Green)

- Provides service between the residential areas and the Palmetto Metrorail Station
- Serviced by 1 trolley
