
Survey Purpose

- Travel characteristics to calibrate transit component of SERPM
- Long range and area-wide planning
- Collect data on:
 - Trip purpose
 - Origin/Destination
 - Mode of access/egress
 - Auto availability
 - Driver's license
 - Demographics
 - Frequency of transit use

Survey Design

- At station/stops and on buses
- Paper survey
- English, Spanish and Creole
- Interview/self-administered
- Pre-printed with a unique serial number
 - Vital tracking device
 - Tied to a particular Busway station/stop
 - Tied to a particular bus

Implementation



- Survey Dates and Times
 - Conducted SW 200th St and south on Wednesday September 14, 2011
 - Conducted north of SW 200th St on Thursday September 15, 2011
 - 4:30 AM to 10:00 PM
- Total of 35 Stations/Stops
 - 30 on Busway
 - 5 off Busway
- Survey teams
 - Station Supervisors
 - Surveyors at stations/stops
 - Surveyors on buses
- Some teams were augmented at rush hour

Methodology

- Surveys were offered to all passengers (12 and over)
- Passengers were asked to take the survey as they approached the station/stop
- Surveys were filled out in an interview format by trained surveyors at all stations/stops
- Surveys were distributed to passengers on buses that began off the Busway for routes 52, 252, 287
- Passengers were counted getting on and off each bus at each station/stop










7. How long do you typically wait at this Busway station/stop?




9. How often do you ride THIS Busway route for a similar trip?






14. What type of place will you END this one-way trip?


18. Do you have a valid DRIVER'S LICENSE?




20. What is your AGE group?




























