MDT RIDERSHIP REPORT FEBRUARY 2003 EXECUTIVE SUMMARY

In February 2003, MDT systemwide average weekday transit ridership (Metrobus, Metrorail, Metromover and Paratransit) was 296,600 experiencing increases of 3.38% from February 2002, of 0.27% from February 2001, and of 6.31% from January 2003. Systemwide average weekend ridership was 281,500, increasing by 8.10% from February 2002, decreasing by 0.67% from February 2001 and increasing by 10.87% when compared to January 2003. Information by mode is as follows:

METROBUS: Weekday boardings for February 2003 averaged 219,200, increasing by 1.34% from February 2002, decreasing by 3.61% from February 2001 and increasing by 6.51% from January 2003. The average weekend boardings were 220,100, experiencing an increase of 4.26% from February 2002, a decrease of 4.05% from February 2001 and an increase of 11.16% from January 2003. Metrobus systemwide average weekday park-ride lot was 1,050 cars, increasing by 4.06% from the previous year and by 6.60% when compared to January 2003.

METRORAIL: Weekday boardings for February 2003 averaged 50,800, showing increases of 2.42% from February 2002, of 3.67% from February 2001 and of 5.83% from January 2003. Average weekend boardings of 39,200, increased by 2.62% from February 2002, decreased by 1.51%, from February 2001, and increased by 11.36% from January 2003. Metrorail's systemwide average weekday parking was 5,790 cars, increasing by 0.94% from the previous year, and by 9.47% when compared to the previous month.

METROMOVER: Weekday boardings for February 2003, averaged 21,800, increasing by 30.54% from February 2002, by 39.74% from February 2001 and by 3.81% from January 2003. The average weekend boardings were 22,200 and showed increases of 100%, 56.34% and 7.25%, from February 2002, February 2001 and January 2003, respectively. The significant increase from the previous years is indicative of the fact that Metromover operates free service, since the passage of the People's Transportation Plan on November 5, 2002.


PARATRANSIT: STS daily trips for February 2003, averaged 3,400, increasing by 13.33% from February 2002, by 36% from February 2001, and by 17.24% from January 2003. The Medicaid program averaged 1,400 for February 2003, increasing by 7.69% from February 2002, February 2001 and January 2003. Over 82% of Medicaid and 74% of STS trips were by ambulatory patrons.


AVERAGE WEEKDAY BOARDINGS BY MODE
















CASH BOARDINGS BY TYPE



 FEBRUARY 2003 VS. FEBRUARY 2002





FEBRUARY 2003 VS. FEBRUARY 2002






