

TECHNICAL RIDERSHIP REPORT

EXECUTIVE SUMMARY

- In February 2007, MDT systemwide average weekday transit ridership (Metrobus, Metrorail, Metromover and Paratransit) was 361,500 experiencing a decrease of 1.82% from February 2006, but increases of 1.63% from February 2005 and of 2.73% from January 2007. Systemwide average weekend ridership was 381,600, decreasing by 2.38% from February 2006, but increasing by 5.76% from February 2005 and by 2.73% from January 2007. Information by mode is as follows:
- **METROBUS**: Weekday boardings for February 2007 averaged 266,600 decreasing by 1.59% from February 2006, but increasing by 2.66% and by 2.46% when compared to February 2005 and January 2007. The average weekend boardings were 303,700, experiencing a decrease of 2.54% from February 2006, but increases of 6.26% from February 2005 and of 4.47% from January 2007. Metrobus systemwide average weekday park-ride lot data averaged 1,463 cars decreasing by 2.7% from the previous year and by 1.8% when compared to the previous month.
- **METRORAIL**: Weekday boardings for February 2007 averaged 61,500 increasing by 1.32% from February 2006, decreasing and by 1.13% when compared to February 2005 and increasing by 2.67% from January 2007. The average weekend boarding was 45,700 decreasing by 6.92%, and 4.19% from February 2006 and February 2005 but increasing by 1.11% from January 2007. Metrorail systemwide average weekday parking averaged 6,748 cars, decreasing by 1.45% from the previous year but increasing by 5.26% when compared to the previous month.
- **METROMOVER**: Weekday boardings for February 2007 averaged 27,700 decreasing by 11.22%, from February 2006 and by 2.46% from February 2005 but increasing by 4.53% when compared to January 2007. The average weekend boardings were 32,200 experiencing increases of 6.62 %, 17.95% and 1.26% from February 2006, February 2005 and January 2007, respectively.
- **PARATRANSIT**: STS daily trips for February 2007 averaged 4,800 increasing by 9.09%, 20.00% and 9.09% from February 2006, February 2005 and January 2007, respectively. The Medicaid program averaged 900 for February 2007, decreasing by 10.00% from February 2006, and by 35.71% from February 2005 but remaining constant when compared to the previous month.







