## TECHNICAL RIDERSHIP REPORT

### EXECUTIVE SUMMARY

- In June 2007, MDT systemwide average weekday transit ridership (Metrobus, Metrorail, Metromover and Paratransit) was 342,000 experiencing a decrease of 0.47% from June 2006, an increase of 8.33% from June 2005 and a decrease of 2.98% from May 2007. Systemwide average weekend ridership was 341,400, decreasing by 2.76% from June 2006, increasing by 2.80% from June 2005 and decreasing by 3.50% from May 2007. Information by mode is as follows:
- **METROBUS:** Weekday boardings for June 2007 averaged 248,100 increasing by 0.04% from June 2006, and by 9.83% from June 2005 and decreasing by 5.63% from May 2007. The average weekend boardings were 270,500, experiencing a decrease of 6.60% from June 2006, an increase of 1.50% from June 2005 and a decrease of 5.09% from May 2007. Metrobus systemwide average weekday park-ride lot data averaged 1,437 cars decreasing by 3.0% from the previous year and by 1.1% when compared to the previous month.
- **METRORAIL:** Weekday boardings for June 2007 averaged 59,900 increasing by 1.53% from June 2006, by 6.39% when compared to June 2005 and by 5.27% from May 2007. The average weekend boarding was 44,500 increasing by 6.21%, 10.97% and 14.40% from June 2006, June 2005 and May 2007, respectively. Metrorail systemwide average weekday parking averaged 6,436 cars, decreasing by 4.72% from the previous year and by 6.22% when compared to the previous month.
- **METROMOVER:** Weekday boardings for June 2007 averaged 28,600 experiencing decreases of 8.33% from June 2006 and of 0.69% June 2005 but increasing by 5.93% from May 2007. The average weekend boardings were 26,400 experiencing increases of 34.69 % from June 2006 and 3.53% from June 2005 but decreasing by 11.71% from May 2007.
- **PARATRANSIT:** STS daily trips for June 2007 averaged 4,500 increasing by 2.27% and by 35.35% from June 2006 and June 2005 but decreasing by 6.25% when compared to the previous month. The Medicaid program averaged 900 for June 2007, decreasing by 10.00% from June 2006, and by 30.77% from June 2005 but remaining constant when compared to the previous month.







