

## TECHNICAL RIDERSHIP REPORT

### EXECUTIVE SUMMARY

- MDT systemwide average weekday transit ridership (Metrobus, Metrorail, Metromover and Paratransit) was 348,000 experiencing decreases of 4.0% from April 2008 and remained constant when compared to April 2007, however, increasing by 2.1% from March 2009. Systemwide average weekend ridership was 342,400, decreasing by 15.9% from April 2008, by 8.2% from April 2007 and by 1.2% from March 2009. Information by mode is as follows:
- **METROBUS:** Weekday boardings for April 2009 averaged 256,600 decreasing by 3.4% from April 2008, and unchanged from April 2007, however, increasing by 1.8% when compared to March 2009. The average weekend boardings were 259,900, experiencing decreases of 18.7% from April 2008 and by 14.2% from April 2007, but increasing by 1.0 % from March 2009. Metrobus systemwide average weekday park-ride lot data averaged 1,515 cars increasing by 1.2% from the previous year but decreasing by 7.6% when compared to the previous month.
- **METRORAIL:** Weekday boardings for April 2009 averaged 61,900 decreasing by 3.9% from April 2008, however increasing by 4.9% from April 2007, and by 2.3% when compared to March 2009. The average weekend boarding was 49,100, experiencing a decrease of 1.4% from April 2007, an increase of 18.9% from April 2008 and a decrease of 10.6% when compared to the previous month. Metrorail systemwide parking patronage was almost 5,300 cars average weekday, a 7% decline versus March 2009.
- **METROMOVER:** Weekday boarding for April 2009 averaged 24,900 experiencing decreases of 9.8% from April 2008 and of 9.1% from April 2007, however increasing by 4.6% when compared to March 2009. The average weekend boarding was 30,800, decreasing by 10.9% from April 2008, increasing by 3.7% from April 2007, but remained constant when compared to March 2009.
- **PARATRANSIT:** STS weekday trips for April 2009 averaged 4,600 experiencing decreases of 5.4% from April 2008, of 2.1% from April 2007 and an increase of 2.2% from March 2009. The weekend trips averaged 3,500 decreasing by 5.4% from April 2008, but remained constant when compared to the previous month.







