# MIAMI DADE TRANSIT

## TECHNICAL RIDERSHIP REPORT

### EXECUTIVE SUMMARY

- MDT systemwide average weekday transit ridership (Metrobus, Metrorail, Metromover and Paratransit) was 300,800 experiencing decreases of 15.4%, 9.4% and 2.4% from July 2008, July 2007 and June 2009. Systemwide average weekend ridership was 347,200, decreasing by 7.2% from July 2008, increasing by 1.0% from July 2007 and by 9.4% from June 2009. Information by mode is as follows:
- **METROBUS:** Weekday boardings for July 2009 averaged 211,400 decreasing by 17.6%, by 13.2% and by 3.7% from July 2008, July 2007 and June 2009. The average weekend boardings were 266,800, experiencing decreases of 2.9% from July 2008, and of 43.3% from July 2007, however, increasing by 14.2 % when compared to June 2009. Metrobus systemwide average weekday park-ride lot data averaged 1,640 cars increasing by 9% from the previous year and the previous month.
- **METRORAIL:** Weekday boardings for July 2009 averaged 58,700 decreasing by 10.2% from July 2008, however increasing by 7.7% from July 2007 and by 1.0% when compared to June 2009. The average weekend boarding was 44,900, experiencing a decrease of 25.0% from July 2008, an increase of 22.7% from July 2007 and a decrease of 7.4% when compared to the previous month. Metrorail systemwide average weekday parking patronage averaged over 4,300 cars, or 17% lower than the previous month.
- **METROMOVER:** Weekday boarding for July 2009 averaged 25,500 experiencing decreases of 9.6%, and 13.6% from July 2008 and July 2007, however increasing by 2.0% from June 2009. The average weekend boarding was 31,900, decreasing by 11.4% from July 2008, however, showing increases of 8.1% and of 1.0% when compared to July 2007 and June 2009.
- **PARATRANSIT:** STS weekday trips for July 2009 averaged 5,200 experiencing a decrease of 3.7% from July 2008, an increase of 15.6% from July 2007 and a decrease of 1.2% June 2009. The weekend trips averaged 3,600 decreasing by 2.7% from July 2008, but remaining constant when compared to the previous month.







