

TECHNICAL RIDERSHIP REPORT

EXECUTIVE SUMMARY

In April 2006, MDT systemwide average weekday transit ridership (Metrobus, Metrorail, Metromover and Paratransit) was 349,500 experiencing a decrease of 0.37% from April 2005, an increase of 11.73% from April 2004 and a decrease of 3.11% from March 2006. Systemwide average weekend ridership was 390,200, increasing by 7.05% from April 2005, by 18.531% from April 2004 but decreasing by 3.56% when compared to the previous month. Information by mode is as follows:

METROBUS: Weekday boardings for April 2006 averaged 260,000 increasing by 3.42% and 14.24% from April 2005, and April 2004 but decreasing by 3.88% from March 2006. The average weekend boardings were 316,100, experiencing a decrease of 6.57% from April 2005, an increase of 10.56% from April 2004 but decreasing by 3.08% from March 2005. Metrobus systemwide average weekday park-ride lot data averaged 1,349 cars increasing by 8.5% from the previous year but decreasing by 9.8% when compared to the previous month.

METRORAIL: Weekday boardings for April 2006 averaged 59,700 showing a decrease of 6.53% from April 2005, an increase of 10.56% from April 2004 but decreasing by 3.08 % when compared to the previous month. The average weekend boarding was 45,100 experiencing a decrease of 7.96% from April 2005, an increase of 4.88% from April 2004, and a decrease of 12.09% when compared to March 2006. Metrorail systemwide average weekday parking averaged 6,771 cars, increasing by 9.74% from the previous year and by 0.76% when compared to the previous month.

METROMOVER: Weekday boardings for April 2006 averaged 24,400 decreasing by 18.67% from April 2005 and by 7.22% from April 2004 and increasing by 3.39% from March 2006. The average weekend boardings were 29,000 experiencing an increase of 21.85% from April 2005, an increase of 24.46% from April 2004 but decreasing by 2.03% when compared to the previous month.

PARATRANSIT: STS daily trips for April 2006 averaged 4,400 increasing by 7.32%, 25.71% and 10.00% from April 2005, April 2004 and March 2006, respectively. The Medicaid program averaged 1,000 for April 2006, showing decreases of 23.57% from April 2005 and April 2004, but remaining constant when compared to March 2006.







