TECHNICAL RIDERSHIP REPORT

EXECUTIVE SUMMARY

- In March 2006, MDT systemwide average weekday transit ridership (Metrobus, Metrorail, Metromover and Paratransit) was 364,100 experiencing increases of 6.71% from March 2005, of 13.46% from March 2004 but decreasing by 0.14% from February 2006. Systemwide average weekend ridership was 408,500, increasing by 10.11% from March 2005, by 17.42% from March 2004 and by 5.47% when compared to the previous month. Information by mode is as follows:
- **METROBUS:** Weekday boardings for March 2006 averaged 270,500 increasing by 9.69% from March 2005, by 13.49% from March 2004 and by 1.20% from February 2006. The average weekend boardings were 323,700, experiencing increases of 11.16%, 16.73% and 5.10% from March 2005, March 2004 and February 2006, respectively. Metrobus systemwide average weekday park-ride lot data averaged 1,495 cars increasing by 31.6% from the previous year but decreasing by 0.6% when compared to the previous month.
- **METRORAIL:** Weekday boardings for March 2006 averaged 61,600 showing increases of 2.84% from March 2005, of 15.14% from March 2004 and of 1.48 % when compared to the previous month. The average weekend boarding was 51,300 experiencing a decrease of 3.21% from March 2005, but increasing by 15.80% from March 2004, and by 4.48% when compared to February 2006. Metrorail systemwide average weekday parking averaged 6,720 cars, increasing by 11.94% from the previous year and by 3.42% when compared to the previous month.
- **METROMOVER:** Weekday boardings for March 2006 averaged 27,000 decreasing by 8.16% from March 2005, increasing by 12.50% from March 2004 and decreasing by 13.46% from February 2006. The average weekend boardings were 33,500 experiencing increases of 25.00% from March 2005, 27.38% from March 2004 and 10.93% when compared to the previous month.
- **PARATRANSIT:** STS daily trips for March 2006 averaged 4,000 remaining constant when compared to March 2005, increasing by 14.29% from March 2005 but decreasing by 9.09% from February 2006. The Medicaid program averaged 1,000 for March 2006, showing decreases of 23.08% from March 2005 and by 28.57% from March 2004, but remaining constant when compared to February 2006.







